Iran Business Visa Guide for International Exhibitors and Business Visitors

- **Business Visa to Iran**

Foreign nationals planning to visit Iran for business meetings, exhibitions, trade fairs, conferences, investment opportunities, contract negotiations, or other commercial activities may apply for an Iran Business Visa (Type A). To ensure sufficient processing time, applicants are advised to begin the visa application process at least 30 days before their intended travel date.

- **Visa-Free Entry**

Iran currently grants visa-free entry to citizens of a number of countries. Visa exemption policies may change from time to time; therefore, travelers are strongly encouraged to verify the latest requirements through the official Iranian e-Visa Portal before making travel arrangements.

- **Passport Requirement**

All visitors to Iran must possess a passport or travel document that remains valid for at least six (6) months beyond the date of entry into Iran.

- **Required Documents for Applicants**

Applicants are generally required to provide:

1. A passport with at least six months validity
2. A recent passport-size photograph
3. A completed visa application form
4. Payment of applicable visa and service fees
5. Additional supporting documents if requested by the Iranian authorities

- **Information Required from the Host Company in Iran**

The inviting company or organization in Iran should provide:

1. Registered company name
2. Company registration number
3. Purpose of invitation and business visit
4. Company address and contact details
5. Official invitation letter on company letterhead, signed and stamped
6. Relevant company registration documents if required by the authorities

Additional documents may be requested depending on the applicant's nationality and the nature of the visit.

- **Processing Time**

Processing times may vary according to nationality and individual circumstances. In many cases, business visa applications are processed within approximately 7–14 working days after submission of complete documentation. Early application is strongly recommended.

- **Official Visa Application**

Applicants can submit their visa requests through the official electronic visa system of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Islamic Republic of Iran: <https://evisa.mfa.ir>

Minimum Space: 36 m² (for each company) In raw space, you couldn't have a prefabricated or Shell Scheme booth



Shell Scheme Booth

Minimum Space: 12 m²

≤ 9 m² is available only for Countries Pavilions. 9- 15 m² has :1 table, 4 chairs, 3 spotlights, 1 electric socket, 1 information desk, and 1 waste bin.

18- 24 m² has: 2 table, 8 chairs, 6 spotlights, 2 electric socket, 2 information desk, and 1 waste bin.

≥ 25 m² has: 3 table, 12 chairs, 9 spotlights, 3 electric socket, 3 information desk, and 1 waste bin.



Constructed Booth

Minimum Space: 36 m²

Normal:

Constructed booth has a normal design and is equipped only with Furniture.

Special:

Constructed booth has a special design and is equipped with a coffee machine, Refrigerator, and TV (50-55 inches).



Maximum Allowed Height for Booth Construction:

Stands in the middle of the halls: 35- 38- 38A- 38 B- 40 & 41 : 4.5M

Stands in the middle of the halls: 44 a & 44b: 3.5 M

Stands next to the wall of halls: 35- 38- 38A- 40 & 41 : 4.5M

Stands next to the wall of halls: 38 B: 3 M

Stands next to the wall of halls: 44 a & 44b: 4 M

- Partition walls that are visible from the back side and walls that are higher than 2.5m should be clean and finished in white.
- It is not permitted to use shell scheme walls from neighbouring stands for your own purposes.
- Kindly note that all booths must have at least partitioned walls and carpeting.

It borders Turkey to the northwest and Iraq to the west, Azerbaijan, Armenia, the Caspian Sea, and Turkmenistan to the north, Afghanistan to the east, Pakistan to the southeast, the Gulf of Oman and the Persian Gulf to the south. With a mostly Persian-ethnic population of almost 90 million in an area of 1,648,195 km² (636,372 sq mi), Iran ranks 17th globally in both geographic size and population. It is the sixth-largest country entirely in Asia and one of the world's most mountainous countries. The country is divided into five regions with 31 provinces.
